Phil received a bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Utah and a master's degree in Business Administration from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania. He makes his living as a licensed structural engineer and works at Alpine Engineering in Hayden, Idaho.

As an athlete, Phil qualified for the U.S. Cycling Nationals the first time he rode a 25 mile trial, and later came within 6 seconds of the American record for the 10 mile time trial. He was also the winner of two World Cup races on the masters FIS alpine ski racing series.

In 2004, Phil Hart was elected by the Citizens of North Idaho to represent District 3 in the Idaho Legislature. District 3 encompasses the northern part of Kootenai County. Phil Hart is actively seeking reelection for the 2006 legislative campaign.
